HUMANITIES ELECTIVES: Any 6 hours of humanities classes in any of the areas listed below

Literature (ENGL)
Foreign Language (FLNG, FREN, GERM, SPAN)
History (HIST)
Communications (COMM)
Philosophy (PHIL)

NATURAL SCIENCES – 3 hours of BISC and 6 additional hours, with at least 3 of those hours in a Physical Science; courses do not need to be in sequence, *but 6 hours must be in the same area* (e.g., 6 hours in CHEM)

Life Sciences – Biology (BISC)
Physical Sciences – Chemistry (CHEM), Geology (GEOL), Physics (PHYS)

FINE ARTS – 3 hours of any classes in any of the area listed below

Art (ART)
Speech Theater (SPTH)
Theatre (THTR)
Music Applied, Private Lessons (MUPV)
Music Ensemble (MUEV)
Music General (MUGN)
Music History and Literature (MUHS)
Music Pedagogy (MUPD)
Music Theory (MUTH)

Or, 3 hours of these specific classes: ARCH 211, ARCH 222, KINE 160, KINE 162, KINE 164, KINE 280
