

SIX STUDENT ATHLETES FROM THE COLLEGE OF BUSINESS EARN ACADEMIC HONORS

RUSTON, La. – Six of Louisiana Tech’s 20 Western Athletic Conference (WAC) Academic All-Conference student-athletes for the fall of 2008 are students with majors in the College of Business.

The list is headlined by Bulldog quarterback and Economics major Ross Jenkins.

Jenkins played in 11 games while starting in Tech’s final eight. The Bulldogs finished 6-2 with Jenkins at the helm, including winning the 2008 Independence Bowl. Jenkins Completed 92 of 174 passes for 1,155 yards and seven touchdowns.

Four members of the Lady Techsters soccer program were among the honorees. Business Administration majors Emily Cleaveland, Kathleen McCullough and Amy Wolsted, and Economics major Katlyn Bachan made the list.

Cleaveland played in 17 games and collected two goals and three assists, while McCullough played in 18 games and scored two goals and had four assists. Wolsted played in all 20 games and had four goals and two assists, and Bachan scored one goal and dished out three assists in 14 games.

Deborah Bolonhini, a Marketing major and a member of the Lady Techsters volleyball team, played in 27 matches as a defensive specialist and collected a team-high 395 digs.

To earn a spot on the academic all-conference team, a student-athlete must maintain a 3.0 GPA and participate in at least 50 percent of their teams’ contests.
